Dear Fellow Anglers,

On behalf of Cranbrook and District Angling Club (CADAC) I would like to provide you with some information about additional activities that the club is providing for this season.

As well as providing opportunities for all Members to pleasure or specimen fish all club venues, as part of the Junior Membership the club also provides opportunities for Adult and juniors to receive coaching. All coaching is by qualified coaches who are trained and have been screened for their suitability for working with young people.

We welcome parents and guardians to all the coaching sessions and value your support. In recognition of this we are holding free parent and child coaching sessions, as well as junior sessions. We are running free* events; Go Fishing Coaching Day and BBQ, a specific Carp Tutorial Day and Family Day and BBQ. We have a pergola to provide a permanent shelter, if needed, as a base during the coaching sessions, the Go Fishing Coaching Day and the Family Day and BBQ. (NB There is a toilet on site.)
