- Tackle and bait is provided for the Junior and Parent & Child coaching sessions.
- Please bring your own tackle for the Carp and Pike Tutorial Days.
- Please wear appropriate clothing.
- Suggest bringing a chair for both child and parent.
- Under 16's should be accompanied by an adult to sign in for the sessions.
- Under 10's MUST be accompanied by an adult for the whole of the sessions or match.
