



CODE OF CONDUCT FOR JUNIOR MEMBERS

The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with Dominic Rodi, Junior Membership Officer.

As a Junior Member of CADAC, you are expected to abide by the following Junior Code of Practice:

- ✓ All members must adhere to Environment Agency (EA) Fishing Byelaws and CADAC Club rules and follow guidance or instructions given by EA/Club Bailiffs or Landowners.
- ✓ All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all anglers, other water users, Landowners or members of the public regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- ✓ Members should keep to agreed timings for coaching or matches and inform their coach if they are going to be late.
- ✓ Members must be suitably equipped with the appropriate tackle as required by the Club Rules or as agreed with the coach.
- ✓ Members must pay any fees for coaching or matches on time.
- ✓ Junior members are not allowed to smoke at club waters or whilst representing the club at matches.
- ✓ Do not expect to night fish club waters if unaccompanied by an adult.
- ✓ Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind whilst at club waters or representing the club at matches.
- ✓ Be considerate to others by keeping noise to a minimum.
