As a Junior Member of CADAC, you are expected to abide by the following Junior Code of Practice:

- All members must adhere to Environment Agency (EA) Fishing Byelaws and CADAC Club rules and follow guidance or instructions given by EA/Club Bailiffs or Landowners.
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all anglers, other water users, Landowners or members of the public regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for coaching or matches and inform their coach
 if they are going to be late.
- Members must be suitably equipped with the appropriate tackle as required by the Club Rules or as agreed with the coach.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke at club waters or whilst representing the club at matches.
- Do not expect to night fish club waters if unaccompanied by an adult.
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind whilst representing the club at matches.
- Be considerate to others by keeping noise to a minimum

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS or CARERS

- Encourage your child to learn the Environment Agency (EA) Fishing Byelaws and CADAC Club Rules and adhere to them, ensure that juniors over twelve are aware of the need for an EA rod licence if over 12 years of age.
- Discourage inconsiderate fishing and confrontation with other anglers and related water users
- Ensure that your child enjoys going fishing regardless of whether they catch fish or not.
- Although we are sure they will want to go never force your child to go fishing if they don't want to
- Set a good example by adhering to EA Fishing Byelaws and CADAC Club Rules and applauding the achievements of other anglers in general fishing or matches
- Never punish or belittle a child for not catching or making a mistake
- Always follow the guidance or instruction of Club Bailiffs or Landowners
- Support your child by going fishing with them and help them enjoy the sport of angling
- Use correct and proper language at all times
- Encourage juniors to have responsibility for their own behaviour
- Ensure your child wears suitable clothing for outdoor activities. Warm clothing in cold weather, a hat in sunny conditions and a carry waterproof coat at any time of the year. Sun cream/block is advisable.
- Endeavour to deliver and collect your child at the arranged time and place.
- Encourage your child to learn to swim.
- Do not leave your child at a venue where they are supposed to be accompanied.
