### Annual General Meeting

Our AGM was held at Marden Village Club on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> February 2016.

37 members attended the recent AGM which was a slightly smaller turn out than last year, many thanks to all those who did come along and showed their support for the club.

The main things to note were:

The membership had increased to its highest level in history at just under 800 full members.

But disappointingly, only 24 of these members attended a work party last year.

The current committee and club officers were all re-elected for another year but we still have vacancies to fill.

**You will all be glad to hear that Subscriptions will remain the same as last season.**

The club will continue its focus on ClubMark activities including coaching sessions, cub/scout open evenings and junior matches. Big thanks to our Level 1 Coaches – Paul Whibley and Mel Dearing for their time and efforts.
