

## **Specific Rules for individual CADAC waters**

## 4.2 Springwood Fishery

- 1. Do not disturb residents when arriving or leaving.
- 2. Park in the designated CADAC car park ONLY. Do not park on the grass. You will have to double park if busy. Leave note of phone number on dash.
- 3. Access to the lakes is from the right hand side of the lodge, do not use path by owners garden.
- 4. No access onto the island for whatever reason, this is STRICTLY out of bounds.
- 5. Keep noise to absolute minimum. That includes bite alarms!
- 6. Keep to the marked paths and keep access gate closed and padlocked. Code is printed on your membership card.
- 7. Top Pool and Long Pool are strictly daylight hours fishing only.
- 8. Night fishing is only permitted on the Main Lake and adjacent Beech Pool.
- 9. Maximum of 48hrs stay in any one swim.
- 10. No junior member to be present here during hours of darkness unless accompanied by an adult.
- 11. Use toilet facilities provided and ensure they are left in a clean and tidy condition.
- 12. Take **ALL** your litter home.
- 13. No fire or BBQs.
- 14. Do not fish further than the middle of the water if the opposite swim is occupied.
- 15. Torches to be used sensibly at dawn and dusk without nuisance to residents.
- 16. No baitboats (also refer to Rule 17 of the General Rules above)
- 17. No live baits are permitted at the request of the water owner
